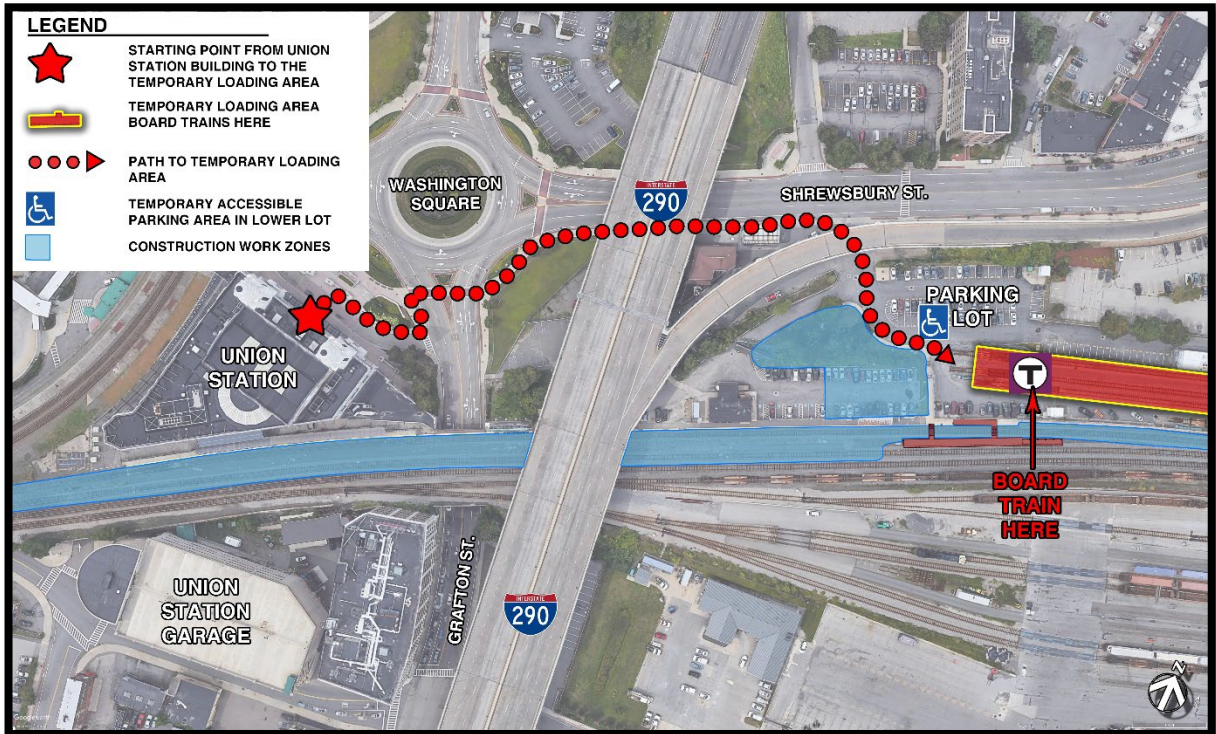

Worcester Union Station: Diversion May 31-July 15



The MBTA continues to upgrade the Worcester Union Commuter Rail Station.

The contractor is planning to begin work that will require a temporary diversion beginning Tuesday May 31 – July 15. The diversion will be Monday- Friday from 9:00am to 3:30pm. Trains arriving before 9:00 am and after 3:30 pm will continue to utilize the existing temporary platform while trains within the outage window will be boarded in the existing layover yard. Amtrak trains will continue to stop at the temporary platform.

Accessible spaces will be available in the lower parking lot located at 45 Shrewsbury Street. These parking spots will be cordoned off with proper signage.

Passengers should allow for some additional time to access the temporary boarding area and are encouraged to use the mobile app to pay for parking as there are no pay stations within the lower parking lot.

We appreciate your patience during this safety related closure and the associated construction to Worcester Union Station.
